Description of Services and Fees

Staff Services **\$400**

- Discuss service options and finalize arrangements
- Professional consultation with licensed personnel which consists of expert advice on options to meet your needs, drafting notices, and advise regarding possible government benefits

Documentation **\$400**

- Completing and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, such as death registration, burial permit, application or interment forms and more

Facilities for Shelter and Care **\$200**

- A secure and private room used to prepare and shelter the body until the time of burial, cremation, or alternative disposition

Basic Preparation of Remains **\$200**

- The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the selected casket

Transportation

- Initial Transfer of Remains **\$150**

Vehicle, trained staff and specialized equipment used to transfer remains into our care from the place of death or coroners office, hospital etc.

- Administrative Vehicle **\$100**

General duty vehicle used to register death and any other necessary paperwork

- Final Transfer of Remains **\$150**

Vehicle and staff to transfer the deceased to final disposition

- Additional transfer **\$150**

Additional transfer needed to transfer deceased from shelter to place of service

Each transfer consists of a 60km radius and any extra distance will be charged at \$2.00 per km

Cremation Deposit **\$350**

- Please note that a \$350 deposit is required for cremation and will be returned back to the family upon pickup of cremated remains. Please note that if remains are not picked up within one year, the transfer service reserves the right to keep the deposit and arrange for interment of the remains

**Please note that all prices do not include HST*

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possible paid for on your behalf by the transfer service to third party providers. Such items include but are not limited to:

Cremation Fee- This fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of the body. The fee varies by crematorium.

Coroners Fee- This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation or alternative disposition or out of province shipping to take place.

Municipal Death Registration Fee- This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the province of Ontario.
